"Sri Lanka Day in Ankara" unravels ifaceted possibilities for mutual economic cooperation -20/07/2023



Sri Lanka Embassy in Türkiye organized a "Sri Lanka Day" event in Ankara together with the Türkiye - Sri Lanka Business Council at the Official Residence of the Ambassador to present opportunities for collaborations in trade, investment, and tourism in Sri Lanka among potential Turkish business community. The event was organized under three segments: 'Trade with Sri Lanka', 'Investing in Sri Lanka', and 'Sri Lanka Tourism'.

In his opening speech, Mr. Mehmet Ali Uğur, Chairman of the Türkiye-Sri Lanka Business Council briefly explained the activities of the Türkiye-Sri Lanka Business Council which started in 2014, and its contributions to the improvement of bilateral commercial relations between the two countries. He highlighted that Sri Lanka's potential is not yet known adequately in Türkiye and thus the aim of the Business Council is to improve relations between the two countries with more awareness on opportunities that exist in the two countries, paving the way for enhancing economic cooperation for mutual benefit.



Mr. Çağatay Özden, the Head of the Department of Asia and Pacific Countries, General Directorate of International Agreements and EU at the Ministry of Trade of Türkiye was the Guest of Honour.

Ms. Thavishya Mullegamgoda, Minister (Commercial) at the Sri Lanka Embassy in Türkiye presented trade, investment, and tourism opportunities in Sri Lanka in detail. Presentations consisted of a basic introduction to Sri Lanka, Sri Lankan product basket for export and introduction to Sri Lanka as land with infinite experiences for the Turkish tourists and potential collaborations in tourism sector.

Presentations were also made by Mr. Mehmet Ali Uğur, Chairman of the Türkiye-Sri Lanka Business Council, who is also the son of the Hony. Consul for Sri Lanka in Adana, the first Turkish businessman in modern times to start a business in Sri Lanka with importing tea from Sri Lanka, about his father's and his experience in doing business with Sri Lanka. Mr. Aydın Özü, an Advisory Board Member of the Penthol Group of Companies, designated Hony. Consul for Sri Lanka in Istanbul, spoke about investment opportunities in Sri Lanka, while, Mr. Mahmut Sami Uluer, Hony. Consul for Sri Lanka in Nevsehir, who also operates hot air balloons for tourists in both Cappadocia, Türkiye and Dambulla-Sigiriya region in Sri Lanka spoke about how it is good for the hospitality industry – for both travel and for investment.

The event was a day-long event with 03 sessions on trade, investment and tourism with lunch and refreshments served and culminated in a cocktail reception at the end for all partcipants.



The Sri Lanka Day event was attended by over 35 representatives of business chambers, organizations, associations, potential Turkish importers, distributors, manufacturers, exporters, investors, travel companies, hotel chains, etc., not only based in Ankara but also from other regions in Türkiye. Some of the Hony. Consuls for Sri Lanka in Türkiye were also among the distinguished quests.
